CONDITIONS OF PLAY



The 2024 Legends Pro-Am will be a 36-hole medley event played over two stipulated rounds, with 18 holes played each day. The days of competition will be 15th and 16th October 2024. This event will be held in conjunction with the TLE ACT PGA Senior Championship.

Eligibility:

The event is open to all male and female amateur golfers who are full financial members of a recognised golf club affiliated with a State Association and having a current GA handicap.

Rules:

The PGA will have control of the TLE ACT PGA Senior Championship competition and where these conditions of play vary from the PGA's requirements, the PGA will override anything in these conditions.

The event will be played as a stableford event for the amateurs and a stroke event for the Professionals.

The event will be conducted with strict adherence to the Rules of Golf, any Local Rules in force and standard regulations contained in the Fairbairn Golf Club By-Laws. This includes any additional requirements in place at the time to comply with current ACT COVID directions.

The Event will be played with morning and afternoon shotgun starts at 07:30 and 12:30 respectively.

The event will be played off the Black tees for male players and the yellow tees for female amateur players.

Handicaps for the tournament will be those held by competitors on the first day of the event. These handicaps will be used for both days as scores will not be uploaded to Golf Link until completion of the second days play.

Players MUST report to the Starter at least 30 minutes before their tee off and an event brief will be held 15 minutes prior to each shotgun start tee off. Failure to report to the Starter may result in disqualification.

All competitors are required to dress in neat golf attire. Soft Spikes are mandatory.

Speed of Play:

To assist in speed of play:

- Only one group will be allocated to start on each tee.
- Players MUST pick up their ball once they cannot score a stableford point on any particular hole.

Entry:

Full entry fee of \$80.00 must be paid by COB Thursday 10th October 2023. Should the field become full, handicaps will be used to determine the final players accepted for the event (any players missing out will have their entry fee refunded). The final draw for the event will be published on the club's website.

Prizes:

There will be two divisions in the amateur field and the divisions will be determined by the numbers of entries received based on an even handicap split.

Prizes will be awarded for:

- Gross and Net Winners and Runners-up for each division (a competitor may win only one major (Gross or Net) prize).
- Two nearest the pin prizes on all par 3s will be awarded each day. One for the amateurs and a separate one for the Professional players. These will be for Capital Brewing Products redeemable at the Fairbairn Golf Club only.
- Wednesday's NTP on the 13th hole:
 - For Amateurs: This NTP will be a year's supply of beer from Capital Brewing (this is one 16 pack of Capital Brewing Co beer a month for 12 months, to be sent out by Capital Brewing to the winner monthly). This prize is not redeemable for cash.
 - For Professionals: This NTP will be a Capital Brewing prize pack.

Ties:

Normal Fairbairn Golf Club count back procedures will be applied to decide prizes for any tied scores for each division.

Seeding:

There will be no seeding of amateur players for the second day. The Professionals will be seeded for their Championship, and this means amateurs will likely be playing with different Professionals on both days.

Match Committee:

The Match Committee of the Fairbairn Golf Club will have control of the event and power to vary Conditions of Play on the day and to decide any dispute or question. The Match Committee's decisions are final and binding.

Practice

Players are reminded of Rule 7.3.2 regarding practice before and during an event. Practice before the start of play on each day, may only be conducted in the recognised practice areas: the practice putting greens, the nets and the driving range. No practice may occur on the course. If you make a stroke in breach of this Rule, you will have the general penalty applied to your first hole. If you make an additional stroke in breach of this Rule, you are disqualified.
